Suicide usually happens because of an underlying mental health disorder and is not generally caused by a single event.

Mental Health Disorders affect the way people feel and prevent them from thinking clearly and rationally. Have a mental health disorder is nothing to be ashamed of and help is available.

The Greenfield School District staff are trained on suicide risk factor and know what to do if a crisis occurs. There are also lessons offered to students on social skills, problem solving skills, coping skills, and help seeking skills.

If staff feels like a student is at risk for suicide, the first step is to contact the CARES hotline. CARES will contact a local SASS Crisis Worker to conduct an assessment of the student to see if they are at high risk for suicide. The worker will then make recommendations for the student.
