GENERAL INFORMATION

The Greenfield Police Department will sponsor a scholarship program for the graduates of Greenfield High School. This Scholarship **MAY** be awarded to more than one recipient at the discretion of the Scholarship selection committee.

Judging:

Applicants will be judged by the Scholarship Selection Committee. The criteria judging is as follows:

- I. Personal Essay
- II. Attendance
- III. Cumulative GPA
- IV. Extra-Cirricular Activities
- V. Financial Need
- VI. Other information

Scholarship Payment:

Recipients must be registering for the Fall Term of their freshman year and attend an accredited institution in the United States and approved by the Scholarship selection committee. A recipient accepted to one of the governmental military academies is considered to have received a full scholarship and cannot receive an award from the Danika Alderfer Memorial scholarship. The intent of the Danika Alderfer Memorial Scholarship program is to pay expenses as designated and outlined by the accredited institution. The scholarship is first to cover books, tuiton, and fees. After those expenses are covered, it can be used for room and board. If a recipient receives an award covering books, tuition, fees, and room and board, they will be unable to utilize this award.

The scholarship award recipients will be announced at the annual graduation ceremony. Each recipient will receive a letter mailed to their home address, which will explain the program and hopefully answer any and all questions. The scholarship will be paid directly to the accredited institution. In no instance will a cash award be presented to the student. The recipient must notify the Superintendent of Schools or the Greenfield Police Department of any changes in plans or scholarship eligibility.
