Application Review:

Applications will be reviewed by a Scholarship Selection Committee, which is composed of members of the Greenfield Foundation for Educational Excellence. The following criteria will be considered:

- I. Personal Essay – Demonstrating Financial Need
- II. Cumulative GPA(Grade Point Average) & Class Rank
- III. ACT or SAT Composite Score
- IV. High School Transcripts (exclude Spring Semester)
- V. Attendance
- VI. Extra-Curricular Activities
- VII. Work Activities
- VIII. Other information

Scholarship Payment:

Three scholarships of \$500 each are available for seniors from Greenfield High School this year. Scholarship recipients must be registering for the fall term of their freshman year and attend an accredited U.S. college, university, or trade school approved by the Greenfield Foundation for Educational Excellence. A recipient accepted to one of the governmental military academies is considered to have received a full scholarship and cannot receive this scholarship.

The scholarship award recipients will be announced at the annual graduation ceremony. Each recipient will be required to submit to the district office proof of enrolling in a college or program of study, such as an acceptance letter and/or registration of classes, before award money will be dispersed to the student. Award money is to be used to cover the costs of books, tuition, fees, and other expenses encountered by the student in continuing their education.
