Criteria and Distribution

- 1. The applicant must be accepted and planning to attend college. (Special consideration will be given to students pursuing a career in Agriculture or related field.)
- The application form must be completed in a clear and professional manner.Forms will be available from the high school counselor.
- 3. Citizenship (conduct) and financial need will be considered.
- 4. The applicant must write an essay to be attached to the application form. The theme of the essay should address one of the following ideas:
 - a) What goals did you set for yourself in high school? How did you plan to attain them, and have you succeeded?
 - b) Relate how a community project in which you have participated has enhanced your education. (Such as 4-H projects, Relay for Life, church service organization, etc.)
 - c) Describe a situation when you had to make an ethical decision and how you made that decision.
- 5. Recipient must successfully complete one semester of college (minimum of 12 credit hours per semester) and present proof of good standing before receiving the monetary portion of the award. Proof of good standing may be provided by Academic Report Card or Certified Transcript, but MUST BE SUBMITTED BY JAN. 15th of the student's freshman year to:

* Checks will be issued within 30 days of receipt of proof of good standing. Failure to submit proof of good standing may result in non-issuance of the monetary portion of the scholarship.

6. Applicant must also obtain and submit a minimum of (2) letters of recommendation from Administrators or Instructors at Greenfield High School, and (1) letter of recommendation from an outside source. (Examples... Work Supervisor, Employer, Chosen Career Field Related Professional.)
