

GREENFIELD COMMUNITY UNIT SCHOOL DISTRICT #10 SCHOOL REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Early registration for the 2017-2018 school year will be held on Tuesday, June 6. The Elementary School and High School will be open on Tuesday, from 9:00 a.m. until 1:00 p.m. and in the evening from 5:00 p.m. until 8:00 p.m. Students will register in the building where the student will attend school. **Regular registration will be held on Wednesday, August 9 for all new students from 1:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. and Thursday, August 10 from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.** All Pre-K students need to register even if they were screened in the spring. Students new to the District are to enroll and pay fees during the designated registration dates. The school counselor will be available during registration for parents and/or students having schedule concerns. Schedule changes will be made the first week of school and must be completed by Friday, August 25th. **All registration forms are available on the District website at: www.greenfieldschools.org.**

Students must be residents of the Greenfield Community Unit School District #10. Parents/guardians may be required to provide two (2) proofs of legal residency. Such proofs include, but are not limited to, tax bill, driver's license, utility bill, or a letter from a landlord. Proof of residency is the responsibility of the parent/guardian. Tuition will be paid to the Greenfield District for any period of time the students attends school as a non-resident. State law requires that all students entering school to be immunized against polio, diphtheria, tetanus, pertussis (whooping cough), measles, and rubella. Children are required to have physical examinations before entering school for the first time and at the 6th and 9th grade levels.

School will begin on Monday, August 21st with a student dismissal time at 1:45 p.m. at the Elementary and 1:55 p.m. at the High School. There will be early dismissals for students on Tuesday-Friday, August 22-25 and Monday-Friday, August 28-September 1 at 1:45 p.m. at the Elementary and 1:55 p.m. at the High School. *Early dismissal times are subject to change and a finalized calendar will be available at registration.* Classes will be in session for full days beginning Tuesday, September 5th.
