Greenfield CUSD #10 has updated security measures in recent years that include: entrance access managed and controlled in main buildings, camera systems, tinted glass with polycarbonate laminated glazing on entrance doors, all secondary entrances locked down unless watched by a staff member, along with a focus on preparation and planning.

Please remember that we must all be responsible for safety. If you hear or see something, say something! The school maintains two full-time principals, a guidance counselor, and a nurse to check on students, issues, or concerns. The local Greenfield Police Department regularly checks in on our schools. Area police officers have conducted trainings in our schools as well as meeting and discussing safety with our staff.

On a brighter topic, congratulations to all of our ROE #40 Olympiad teams! Greenfield CUSD #10 led all area schools with 7 medals this year! These teams represent only a small portion of the exceptional and hard-working students that we have in our schools.
