

THE MINUTES OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF
GREENFIELD COMMUNITY UNIT SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 10
May 18, 2015

The Board of Education of Greenfield Community Unit School District No. 10 met in regular session, in the Administrative Office, on May 18, 2015.

1. President Russ Bishop called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Upon roll call the following members were present: Chris Goode, Elliott Turpin, Jim Trump, Rodney Knittel, Josh Roberts, Chris Weller and Russ Bishop. Also present were Superintendent Kevin Bowman, Elementary Principal Chris Raynor, High School Principal Beth Bettis, Julie Williams, Julie George, Tyann Hallock, Luann Hubbard, Aubrey Jenkins, LaCretia Huff and Becky McClelland.
2. There were no additions or deletions from the Agenda. It was motioned by Roberts, seconded by Goode, to approve the Agenda as presented. Upon roll call Weller, Trump, Goode, Knittel, Roberts, Turpin and Bishop voted "Aye". Motion carried.
3. Trump motioned and Knittel seconded to approve the April 20, 2015 regular meeting, April 20, 2015 executive session minutes, May 2, 2015 special meeting minutes, and May 2, 2015 executive session minutes. Upon roll call Trump, Weller, Turpin, Goode, Knittel, Roberts and Bishop voted "Aye". Motion carried.

5. Under District Highlights, Aubrey Jenkins displayed her award-winning garment to the Board. Aubrey qualified at the FCCLA state competition to take her garment made of recycled materials to the National Convention in Washington, D.C. in July of 2015.
6. Board President Bishop congratulated the Junior High Boys' and Girls' Track team, Coach Tyann Hallock and Coach Jennifer Grummel on their showing at the State Competition.
7. Sam Walden reported on the following:
 - Health/Life/Safety Survey-waiting on approval from the Illinois State Board of Education
 - Refrigerator at the Elementary has been repaired
 - A server was donated to the District and has been installed at the elementary
 - A new server will be purchased with REAP grant funds and installed at the high school this summer
8. Superintendent Bowman reported the District has received three mandated categorical payments from ISBE.
9. High School Principal Bettis reported on the updated High School Curriculum Guide. Two new classes will be offered next year. A Health and Fitness class will be offered along with a new social sciences class titled "The 1960's". The new STEM class that was offered this year has been met with enthusiasm by the students.

Northwestern will share 50% of the loss from Junior High Basketball and they will be responsible for transporting their students to Greenfield for all practices and games.
