

THE MINUTES OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF  
GREENFIELD COMMUNITY UNIT SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 10  
June 26, 2017

The Board of Education of Greenfield Community Unit School District No. 10 met in regular session, in the Administrative Office, on June 26, 2017 for a Public Hearing.

1. President Rodney Knittel called the Tuition Waiver Public Hearing to order at 6:30 p.m. Upon roll call the following members were present: Josh Roberts, Joe Kinser, Elliott Turpin, Brandi Rynders and Rodney Knittel. Chris Weller and Chris Goode were absent. Also present were Superintendent Kevin Bowman, High School Principal Beth Bettis, GEA President Beth Burrow and Becky McClelland. Chris Goode entered the meeting at 6:33 p.m.
2. Superintendent Bowman read the Tuition Waiver Request. President Knittel asked for public testimony. Hearing none, Roberts motioned and Rynders seconded to adjourn the public hearing. Upon roll call Rynders, Goode, Kinser, Roberts, Turpin and Knittel voted "Aye". Motion carried. Public Hearing adjourned at 6:35 p.m. (See Exhibit No. 1 attached to the Official Minutes)
3. President Rodney Knittel called regular meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Upon roll call the following members were present: Josh Roberts, Chris Goode, Joe Kinser, Chris Weller, Elliott Turpin, Brandi Rynders and Rodney Knittel. Also present were Superintendent Kevin Bowman, High School Principal Beth Bettis, Ron Plogger, GEA President Beth Burrow, Jacob Bollman, Samantha Allen and Becky McClelland.
4. Turpin motioned and Roberts seconded to approve the amended agenda as presented. Upon roll call Weller, Rynders, Goode, Kinser, Roberts, Turpin and Knittel voted "Aye". Motion carried.
5. Roberts motioned and Weller seconded to approve the May 15, 2017 regular, special and executive session minutes, May 30, 2017 special meeting and executive session minutes as presented. Upon roll call Roberts, Weller, Turpin, Goode, Kinser, Rynders and Knittel voted "Aye". Motion carried.
6. Rynders motioned and Goode seconded to approve the Consent Agenda as presented. Upon roll call Turpin, Rynders, Weller, Roberts, Goode, Kinser and Knittel voted "Aye". Motion carried. (See Exhibit No. 2 attached to the Official Minutes)
7. District Highlights – Samantha Allen, Middle School Computer/English teacher reported on the recent Google conference she attended. Ms. Allen will be teaching K-5 students computer and coding skills in 2017-2018 school year instead of supervising study hall.
8. Superintendent Bowman reported on the FRIS monthly report. At the current time, the State of Illinois owes approximately \$275,000 to the district.
9. Ron Plogger reported on Facilities/Transportation:
  - Football scoreboard has been removed and new one should be up by June 29<sup>th</sup>
  - Elementary gym project-skin has been removed from west side and studs are up

- Ameren has completed the electrical upgrade at the Elementary and all service is now underground
- Long jump and discus area will be renovated this summer
- Will ask the board to accept sealed bids for the old football scoreboard
- May was a very busy month for transportation
- No delivery date has been set for the new bus

10. Elliott Turpin reported the Greenfield Foundation for Educational Excellence presented eight scholarships at the recent high school graduation ceremonies. The next meeting will be held on the third Wednesday in August.

11. The Prevailing Wage Ordinance was introduced for the annual authorization. This ordinance is mandated by the State of Illinois. (See Exhibit No. 3 attached to the Official Minutes)

12. Superintendent Bowman reported Personnel changes:

- Accept retirement of Title 1 Teacher
- Reduce vacant Title 1 position to part-time position - .27 FTE
- Re-assign Title II Class-Size Reduction teacher to part-time Title 1 position
- Accept (2) three-year notice of retirements
- Employ Head and Assistant Cheerleader Sponsors
- Employ one-on-one teacher aide
- Employ High School Volleyball Assistant Coach
- Hunt Scholarships-None
- Greenfield-Northwestern Coop – Spring Sports Revenue/Expense
- Prairie State Insurance Cooperative – Annual Package renewal for 2017-2018

13. Roberts motioned and Rynders seconded to go into Executive Session at 7:20 p.m. Upon roll call Rynders, Kinser, Roberts, Turpin, Goode, Weller and Knittel voted “Aye”. Motion carried.

Roberts motioned and Turpin seconded to return to Open Session at 10:30 p.m. Upon roll call Kinser, Roberts, Turpin, Goode, Weller, Rynders and Knittel voted “Aye”. Motion carried.

14. Roberts motioned and Rynders seconded to employ Jeremy Lansaw as the Elementary Principal for the 2017-2018 school year. Lansaw accepted a one-year contract at \$62,000 with board paid TRS, board paid single health insurance and an effective date of hire as July 1<sup>st</sup>. Upon roll call Weller, Rynders, Kinser, Roberts, Turpin, Goode and Knittel voted “Aye”. Motion carried.

15. Turpin motioned and Goode seconded to accept the retirement of Judy Bishop, effective the end of the 2016-2017 school year. Upon roll call Rynders, Kinser, Roberts, Turpin, Goode, Weller and Knittel voted “Aye”. Motion carried.

16. Rynders motioned and Roberts seconded to approve the reduction of a vacant Title 1 position to a part-time position .27 FTE. Upon roll call Kinser, Roberts, Turpin, Goode, Weller, Rynders and Knittel voted “Aye”. Motion carried.

17. Turpin motioned and Rynders seconded to re-assign a Title II Class Size Reduction teacher to the Title 1 part-time .27 FTE position. Upon roll call Roberts, Turpin, Goode, Weller, Rynders, Kinser and Knittel voted "Aye". Motion carried.
18. Goode motioned and Weller seconded to accept two (3) Year Notice of Retirements from Debra Royer and Linda Williams. Upon roll call Turpin, Goode, Weller, Rynders, Kinser, Roberts and Knittel voted "Aye". Motion carried. (See Exhibits No. 4 and 5 attached to the Official Minutes)
19. Roberts motioned and Rynders seconded to employ Melissa McMillen as the Head Cheerleader sponsor and Cassie Borcky as the Assistant Cheerleader sponsor. Upon roll call Weller, Rynders, Kinser, Roberts, Turpin, Goode and Knittel voted "Aye". Motion carried.
20. Rynders motioned and Weller seconded to hire Katherine Coates as a one-on-one teacher aide for the 2017-2018 school year. Upon roll call Weller, Rynders, Kinser, Roberts, Turpin, Goode and Knittel voted "Aye". Motion carried.
21. Rynders motioned and Kinser seconded to employ Rachael Goodall as the High School Volleyball Assistant Coach. Upon roll call Rynders, Kinser, Roberts, Turpin, Goode, Weller and Knittel voted "Aye". Motion carried.
22. Roberts motioned and Kinser seconded to adopt the Prevailing Wage Ordinance as required by law. Upon roll call Rynders, Kinser, Roberts, Turpin, Goode, Weller and Knittel voted "Aye". Motion carried. (See Exhibit No. 3 attached to the Official Minutes)
23. Goode motioned and Weller seconded to approve the submission of the Tuition Waiver proposal to the Illinois Board of Education. Upon roll call Kinser, Roberts, Turpin, Goode, Weller, Rynders and Knittel voted "Aye". Motion carried. (See Exhibit No. 1 attached to the Official Minutes)
24. Turpin motioned and Roberts seconded to approve the Resolution authorizing the abatement of Working Cash Fund in the amount of \$150,000 to the Education Fund. Upon roll call Roberts, Turpin, Goode, Weller, Rynders, Kinser and Knittel voted "Aye". Motion carried. (See Exhibit No. 6 attached to the Official Minutes)
25. Roberts motioned and Goode seconded to authorize the Superintendent to seek sealed bids on the old football field scoreboard with bids to be opened at the August board meeting. Upon roll call Turpin, Goode, Weller, Rynders, Kinser, Roberts and Knittel voted "Aye". Motion carried.
26. Roberts motioned and Kinser seconded to cancel the July board meeting. Upon roll call Weller, Rynders, Kinser, Roberts, Turpin, Goode and Knittel voted "Aye". Motion carried.
27. There was no correspondence or announcements
28. Turpin motioned and Rynders seconded to adjourn the meeting at 10:50 p.m. All verbally voted "Aye". Motion carried.
