

THE MINUTES OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF  
GREENFIELD COMMUNITY UNIT SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 10  
May 21, 2018

The Board of Education of Greenfield Community Unit School District No. 10 met in regular session, in the Administrative Office, on May 21, 2018.

1. President Rodney Knittel called the regular meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Upon roll call the following board members were present: Josh Roberts, Chris Goode, Joe Kinser, Elliott Turpin, Brandi Rynders and Rodney Knittel. Chris Weller was absent. Also present were Superintendent Kevin Bowman, High School Principal Beth Bettis, Elementary Principal Jeremy Lansaw, Jacob Bollman and Becky McClelland.
2. Rynders motioned and Turpin seconded to approve the amended agenda as presented. Upon roll call Rynders, Goode, Kinser, Roberts, Turpin and Knittel voted "Aye". Motion carried.
3. Roberts motioned and Kinser seconded to approve the April 16, 2018 regular and executive session minutes as presented. Upon roll call Roberts, Turpin, Goode, Kinser, Rynders and Knittel voted "Aye". Motion carried.
4. Goode motioned and Rynders seconded to approve the consent agenda as presented. Upon roll call Turpin, Rynders, Roberts, Goode, Kinser and Knittel voted "Aye". Motion carried. (See Exhibit No. 1 attached to the Official Minutes)
5. District Highlights – Jacob Bollman, District Chorus/Music/Band teacher reported the high school chorus won the State Vocal Championship award. The high school chorus competed in twenty-two events with sixteen students and scored 96 points overall. The chorus placed first in the entire state in Class D schools. Bollman and students were congratulated on this major accomplishment.
6. Superintendent Bowman handed out information on EBM and ESSA. The first acronym stands for "Evidence Based Funding Model" and is the new funding model the State of Illinois has enacted to provide equity in funding for schools. ESSA stands for "Every Student Succeeds Act". This replaced the old "No Child Left Behind" program.
7. Superintendent Bowman reviewed area pay for athletic officials. There is a recommendation to increase the rate of pay for some officials to be competitive with area schools.
8. Superintendent Bowman reported on Facilities/Transportation:
  - Mulch has been delivered and will be spread during the summer
  - Southside Hardware quoted (2) air-conditioning systems for the high school gym at a cost of \$23,387. Electrical upgrades would also be needed to run the system at a cost of \$5,584.
  - District Office roof will be replaced this summer at a cost of \$3,359 due to a leak
  - Missouri Flooring inspected the new elementary floor and made recommendations
  - Two bus bids have been received and the recommendation is to purchase a 2019 bus from Midwest Transit. (See Exhibit No. 2 attached to the Official Minutes)

9. Elliott Turpin reported on the Greenfield Foundation for Educational Excellence. The last meeting of the school year was held on May 16<sup>th</sup>. GFEE will award ten \$500 scholarships to graduating seniors. The bank balance stands at \$14,591.46.
10. Superintendent Bowman reported on:
  - FRIS financial update
  - AIRSS annual renewal
  - Hunt scholarship application was presented (See Exhibit No. 3 attached to the Official Minutes)
  - Risk Management document was reviewed (See Exhibit No. 4 attached to the Official Minutes)
  - Treasurer's bond renewal (See Exhibit No. 5 attached to the Official Minutes)
  - Reviewed 2018-2019 registration fees and lunch prices (See Exhibit No. 6 attached to the Official Minutes)
11. Beth Bettis, High School Principal, noted there were no changes in the Curriculum Guide for the high school. She noted that she does include career plan lessons for each grade level.
12. Elementary and High School handbooks were presented to the board for approval.
13. Superintendent Bowman reported on Personnel:
  - Athletic recommendations for 2018-2019
  - Part-time summer employment update
  - Accept resignation – Nick Troutwine
  - Hire extended school year aide – Dianne Vincent
  - Hire extended school year aide – Laura Schild
  - Hire assistant football coach – Jon Dierkes
  - Hire elementary teacher – Amber Meehan
14. Superintendent Bowman presented the only bid received for the high school window project from Limbaugh Construction. (See Exhibit No. 7 attached to the Official Minutes)
15. IDEA Determination review for the 2016-2017 school year concluded that Greenfield CUSD #10 meets all requirements in regards to special education services. Bowman congratulated Beth Bettis, Jeremy Lansaw and the special education staff in achieving this designation.
16. Bids for milk and bread were reviewed. (See Exhibit No. 8 attached to the Official Minutes)
17. Superintendent Bowman presented a list of textbooks for consideration for the 2018-2019 school year.
18. Luann Hubbard, FCCLA sponsor, is requesting permission for three students and herself to travel to Atlanta, Georgia to the FCCLA national convention.

19. Superintendent Bowman reviewed board policies 4:80-Operational Services; 6:60-Curriculum Content; 7:50-School Admissions and Student Transfers; 6:130-Program for the Gifted; and 6:135-Accelerated Placement Program. These policies will be action items in June. (See Exhibit No. 9 attached to the Official Minutes)

20. Rynders motioned and Kinser seconded to go into Executive Session at 7:58 p.m. Upon roll call Rynders, Kinser, Roberts, Turpin, Goode and Knittel voted "Aye". Motion carried.

Roberts motioned and Kinser seconded to return to Open Session at 8:10 p.m. Upon roll call Kinser, Roberts, Turpin, Goode, Rynders and Knittel voted "Aye". Motion carried.

21. Roberts motioned and Kinser seconded to accept all athletic recommendations for 2018-2019 as presented. Upon roll call Rynders, Kinser, Roberts, Turpin, Goode and Knittel voted "Aye". Motion carried.

22. Kinser motioned and Rynders seconded to hire Rose Parker, Roshier Creecy, Blake Meyer, Clinton Nettles, and Ben Bayless as part-time summer maintenance workers at 20 hours per week. The board had previously voted to hire 3-4 at 24 hours per week. All workers will be paid \$8.25 per hour. Upon roll call Rynders, Kinser, Roberts, Turpin, Goode and Knittel voted "Aye". Motion carried.

23. Turpin motioned and Goode seconded to accept the resignation of Nick Troutwine as a football assistant coach. Upon roll call Rynders, Kinser, Roberts, Turpin, Goode and Knittel voted "Aye". Motion carried.

24. Kinser motioned and Roberts seconded to hire Dianne Vincent as an extended school year aide. Upon roll call Rynders, Kinser, Roberts, Turpin, Goode and Knittel voted "Aye". Motion carried.

25. Rynders motioned and Turpin seconded to hire Laura Schild as an extended school year aide. Upon roll call Rynders, Kinser, Roberts, Turpin, Goode and Knittel voted "Aye". Motion carried.

26. Roberts motioned and Goode seconded to hire Jon Dierkes as an assistant football coach for 2018-2019. Upon roll call Rynders, Kinser, Roberts, Turpin, Goode and Knittel voted "Aye". Motion carried.

27. Kinser motioned and Goode seconded to hire Amber Meehan as an Elementary teacher for the 2018-2019 school year. Upon roll call Kinser, Roberts, Turpin, Goode, Rynders and Knittel voted "Aye". Motion carried.

28. Turpin motioned and Roberts seconded to approve the 2018 Risk Management Plan as presented. Upon roll call Roberts, Turpin, Goode, Rynders, Kinser and Knittel voted "Aye". Motion carried. (See Exhibit No. 4 attached to the Official Minutes)

29. Kinser motioned and Rynders seconded to approve the annual membership fee for the Association of Illinois Rural and Small Schools. Upon roll call Turpin, Goode, Rynders, Kinser, Roberts and Knittel voted "Aye". Motion carried.

30. Goode motioned and Kinser seconded to approve the 2018-2019 High School Curriculum Guide. Upon roll call Goode, Rynders, Kinser, Roberts, Turpin and Knittel voted "Aye". Motion carried.
31. Roberts motioned and Rynders seconded to approve a \$2,000 Hunt Scholarship Loan application from Katelyn Heavner. Upon roll call Rynders, Kinser, Roberts, Turpin, Goode and Knittel voted "Aye". Motion carried. (See Exhibit No. 3 attached to the Official Minutes)
32. Roberts motioned and Kinser seconded to approve the bus bid from Midwest Transit for a 2019 -71 passenger bus with a net cost of \$67,548 and an additional \$2300 for a camera system.
