

THE MINUTES OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF
GREENFIELD COMMUNITY UNIT SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 10
June 17, 2019

The Board of Education of Greenfield Community Unit School District No. 10 met in regular session, in the Administrative Office, on June 17, 2019.

1. President Knittel called the regular meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Upon roll call the following members were present: Josh Roberts, Chris Goode, Elliott Turpin, Brandi Rynders and Rodney Knittel. Joe Kinser and Chris Weller were absent. Also present were Superintendent Kevin Bowman, High School Principal Beth Bettis, Ron Plogger, Beth Burrow, Rachel and Zack Wright, Garry White, Dan and Luke Lorton, Gavin and Bradley Rynders, Addison Arnold, Nick Bishop, Dave Bishop and Becky McClelland.

2. Roberts motioned and Goode seconded to approve the agenda as presented. Upon roll call Rynders, Goode, Roberts, Turpin and Knittel voted "Aye". Motion carried.

3. Roberts motioned and Rynders seconded to approve the May 20, 2019 regular and executive session minutes as presented. Upon roll call Roberts, Turpin, Goode, Rynders and Knittel voted "Aye". Motion carried.

Chris Weller entered the meeting at 7:02 p.m.

4. Rynders motioned and Goode seconded to approve the Consent Agenda as presented. Upon roll call Turpin, Rynders, Weller, Roberts, Goode and Knittel voted "Aye". Motion carried. (See Exhibit No. 1 attached to the Official Minutes)

5. District Highlights- High School Trap Team – Coaches Brandi Rynders and Garry White thanked the BOE for supporting the High School Trap Team. The team had an impressive list of accomplishments and presented the school with two plaques.

District Agriculture Education Teacher Beth Burrow reviewed the program's many activities and accomplishments with a slide show. She also updated the BOE on grants received and donated items for the shop. They included a Monsanto \$10,000 grant, FFA Living \$1200 grant, Farm Credit \$500 grant and the Ag Education \$10,000 grant. The FFA Alumni have given two \$500 scholarships to students. Rankin donated 3 welders to the program. The shop area is being re-wired and updated for the new welders this summer.

Greenfield Mayor Nick Bishop and Dave Bishop presented Mrs. Burrow with a plaque thanking her for her dedication to the students of Greenfield. The BOE also thanked Mrs. Burrow for her dedication in serving students.

6. Superintendent Bowman updated the BOE on FRIS report.

7. Ron Plogger reported on Facilities/Transportation:

- Mulch was delivered to the Elementary and PreK swing set has been set up
- Dirt work to be finished around buildings for water run-off
- District Office roof – plan to start re-roofing next week
- Elementary fence – in progress
- Trees were planted on top of the hill by Mrs. Burrow's class

- Ag Shop renovation is ongoing
- District Office carpet will be replaced the end of June
- Chris Weller reported he has access to 80 foot poles for free. Ameren will give them to us if we haul them away. Bowman will check to see if there are any restrictions on wooden poles.

8. Elliott Turpin reported on the Greenfield Foundation for Education Excellence. The next meeting will be held in August. Nineteen scholarships were awarded to graduating seniors.
9. Superintendent Bowman reported that due to a new law the District does not have to determine the Prevailing Wage rate, approve an annual ordinance or publish the notice of approval in the newspaper.
10. Superintendent Bowman provided the 2019-2020 Prairie State Insurance Cooperative Insurance Package Renewal for review.
11. Superintendent Bowman reviewed Board Policy 5:210 with the BOE. There will need to be a motion to keep this policy in place. (See Exhibit No. 2 attached to the Official Minutes)
12. Superintendent Bowman is recommending that a 2019 Ford Fusion sedan be purchased to use as the Driver's Education vehicle for \$22,958.00. (See Exhibit No. 3 attached to the Official Minutes)
13. Superintendent Bowman reported on Personnel:
 - Accept resignation of Pee Wee Boys' Basketball Asst. Coach
 - Hire two teacher aides
 - Re-approve 3 year notice of retirement for Toni Longmeyer and Pam Arnold (See Exhibit No. 4 attached to the Official Minutes)
14. There was no action on Facilities.
15. There was no action on Transportation.
16. Roberts motioned and Rynders seconded to cancel the July board meeting. Upon roll call Roberts, Turpin, Goode, Weller, Rynders and Knittel voted "Aye". Motion carried.
17. Goode motioned and Weller seconded to approve the continuation of Board Policy 5:210 – Professional Personnel – Retirements and Resignations. Upon roll call Roberts, Turpin, Goode, Weller, Rynders and Knittel. Motion carried. (See Exhibit No. 2 attached to the Official Minutes)
18. Roberts motioned and Turpin seconded to purchase a 2019 Ford Fusion from Morrow Brothers Ford for \$22,985 as presented. Upon roll call Turpin, Goode, Weller, Rynders, Roberts and Knittel voted "Aye". Motion carried. (See Exhibit No. 3 attached to the Official Minutes)
19. Rynders motioned and Roberts seconded to accept the resignation of Roshier Creecy as the Pee Wee Boys' Basketball Assistant Coach. Upon roll call Goode, Weller, Rynders, Roberts, Turpin and Knittel voted "Aye". Motion carried.
20. Rynders motioned and Weller seconded to hire Julie Cole as a teacher aide for the 2019-2020 school term. Upon roll call Weller, Rynders, Roberts, Turpin, Goode and Knittel voted "Aye". Motion carried.
21. Goode motioned and Rynders seconded to hire Kathleen Larsen as a teacher aide for the 2019-2020 school term. Upon roll call Rynders, Roberts, Turpin, Goode, Weller and Knittel voted "Aye". Motion carried.

22. Roberts motioned and Rynders seconded to re-approve 3-year notice of retirements per Board Policy 5:210 for Toni Longmeyer and Pam Arnold. Upon roll call Weller, Rynders, Roberts, Turpin, Goode and Knittel voted “Aye”. Motion carried. (See Exhibit No. 4 attached to the Official Minutes)
