

Greenfield CUSD 10 and Erin's Law

Erin's Law (105 ILCS 5/10-23.13) was passed in Illinois in 2011. It requires that all public schools adopt and implement a policy regarding child-focused sexual abuse prevention education that includes age-appropriate curriculum for students in pre-K through twelfth grade on how to recognize child sexual abuse and tell a trusted adult; training for school personnel on child sexual abuse; and educational information for parents and guardians on the warning signs of child sexual abuse, along with needed assistance, referrals, and resources.
